## **WEATHER INFO**

The Fire Engine Visit is an outside activity of course, and it is affected by the weather. Wet day bookings carry a risk, and very hot days can also spoil outside activity plans.

## **Wet Days**

If you get a day with consistent drizzle, steady rain and certainly if it's stormy, then the Fire Engine visit can't go ahead.

Also if the winds are high or there is a chance of gale force winds, the Fire Engine can't go ahead. If there is a ROAD WEATHER ALERT, that will be an indicator of concern also.

If your Party Day has some intermittent light rain with fine breaks, it **might** be manageable, in which case the Fire Engine Rides and Firehose game can usually go ahead.

## **Very Hot Days**

January to March often have some scorching days with hot dry winds. The Fire Engine has shade covers, but it may be too hot for small children to be outside. There is no problem if you cancel because it's simply too uncomfortably hot to be outside, and you need to keep everyone indoors.
