

WET WEATHER INFO

Hello everyone, Kevin here.....

The Fire Engine visit is an outside activity of course, and we have no control over the conditions that come on our party day.

If you need to cancel your Fire Engine visit and keep your party indoors, there is no fuss this end. Bad Weather is no one's fault. Also none of us can afford to get cold and wet, especially these days. Even a sniffle is to be avoided.

If we get a day with some intermittent light rain and fine breaks it is manageable with the Fire Engine rain covers, and the Firehose game can usually be done from under a car port etc.

If it is more than that, consistent rain, stormy, high winds etc, the Fire Engine can't go ahead. I don't take children out for a Fire Engine ride during poor weather.

Usually the party host and I work together, we keep our eyes on the forecast and decide if a Fire Engine visit is going ahead. Some party hosts need to plan ahead rather than wait and see. They will make a decision from the Long Range Forecast days ahead. Most are going ahead with their party regardless of the weather, and flow with what happens on the day.

It is important to 'hedge your bets' during Wet Season Parties. Have some indoor games up your sleeve, a 'PLAN B'.
